

Folklore Minor Worksheet

The interdisciplinary folklore minor requires sixteen credits, including ENG 365 Folklore (3 credits); SOAN 191 Anthropological Inquiry (3 credits); IDSM 300 Folklore Colloquium (taken twice for a total of 1 credit); one other course from those listed under Area I Theory and Methodology; and two other courses listed under Area I, II (Cultural Group), or III (Cultural Product). At least nine credits in the minor must be at the 300 level or above.

Students must also complete either (a) a folklore-related capstone in their home major; (b) an independent, mentored, folklore capstone project; or (c) a for-credit internship in a folklore-related field.

For general requirements, note the semester in which you completed the course and the grade you received. For other requirements, please also list the courses you took and the semester in which you took them. For capstones other than internships and senior seminars, please provide the signature of your teacher or mentor.
